Senior class float was selected as the winner of this competition. The float reflected many hard hours of dedicated work by senior class members.

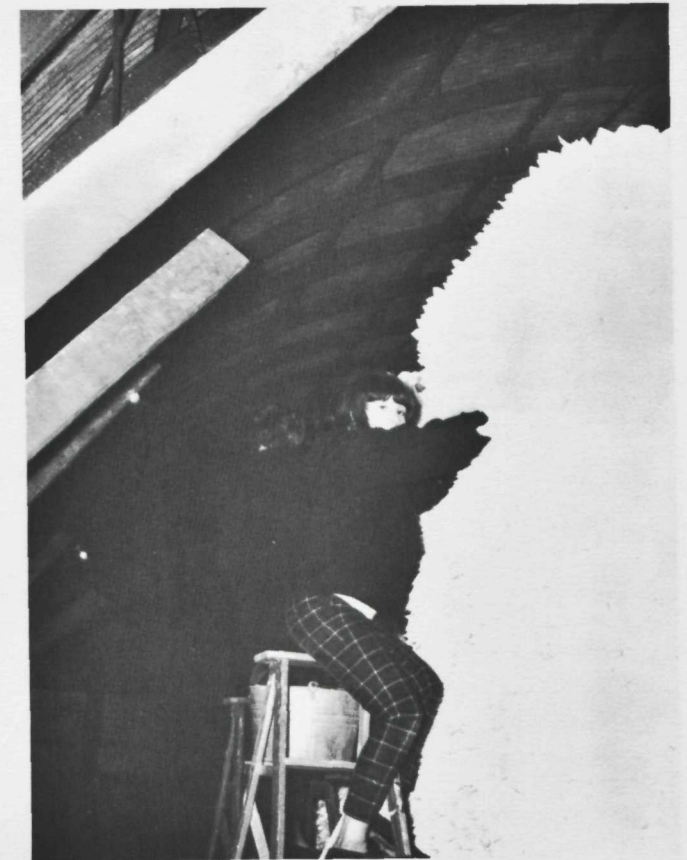
